Ahead of a major new documentary series featuring Sellafield, the BBC visited JFN's Egremont site to get the inside track on the work JFN is currently undertaking with Sellafield and their ongoing decommissioning activity. ROVs are used extensively for characterisation, video surveying and size reduction within Sellafield's storage ponds. These remotely operated miniature submersible vehicles allow the operators to gain access areas that would be extremely hazardous and are helping to reduce the time taken and costs incurred to carry out this vital work.

Within the piece Simon Pyne, Business Development Manager explains a little of what we do now and how we are using the techniques developed on site to take JFN's expertise to a worldwide market and help create a highly skilled workforce in Cumbria, who's knowledge and experience will be in great demand around the globe.
